

Visas and Entry Documents for MBA Global Programs

It is your responsibility to determine whether you need a visa or entry document to participate in a global program. It is also your responsibility to obtain the necessary visa or entry documents.

Do not financially commit to a global program before confirming the visa requirements of your destination. Once you have committed to the program, begin the visa application process immediately if applicable.

If you fail to obtain your visa, you will be subject to the withdrawal & refund schedule for the program and therefore may not be eligible for any refund.

The Global Programs team can provide a variety of documents to support your visa application. Some examples include:

- Letter of support confirming that you are a UNC student in good standing
- Proof of health insurance
- Proof of accommodation
- Itinerary
- Ticket receipts for in-program travel

You must contact our team to request these documents. We do not know what documents you need without your request, and we will not provide documents that are not specifically requested.

All travelers must ensure that their passports and United States visas are up-to-date and ready for travel. As a general rule, passports must have six months' validity after the traveler's expected return.

International students should confirm that their student visas will not expire while abroad to avoid issues during re-entry.

In some rare cases, a visa or travel authorization may be required while transiting through another country on the way to your final destination (e.g., a travel authorization may be required for a layover in the UK). You are also responsible for researching these travel requirements and obtaining the necessary documentation.
